Clubs - from September

Thank you to everyone who filled in the survey re after-school provision, which we will continue to review periodically, in line with parental demand.

Analysis (and current attendance figures) show that there is a much greater demand for Tues-Thur and that a good proportion of parents would appreciate a slightly later finish time of 4.30pm. Our themed clubs on a Tues-Thurs will therefore finish at the later time of 4.30pm, from September. Mon & Fri clubs will run until 4.15pm.

Further, there were a very small number of parents who would like the club to run 5pm, or even later. Whilst we of course want to be able to offer provision which supports our working parents, attendance figures need to be high enough that it is financially viable for us as a school. Based upon the number of responses, it still would not be. However, we do often gain some ad-hoc attendees.

We therefore propose to trial running Wednesday's club until 5pm for the first half term. We will then review attendance in October and make a further decision about future provision at that point.
